### **Who can take the CELTA course.**

From recent graduates, people who are changing career, or other teachers / lectures who want to gain a formal qualification in ESL teaching and may want to progress to qualifications such as the Cambridge DELTA (Teach the teacher qualification). The CELTA course is also the ideal course for candidates entering the profession with little or no teaching experience.

The practical course is aimed at providing you with a firm grounding in teaching skills and techniques. It will also help you to develop your language awareness and your sensitivity to the difficulties experienced by foreign language learners.

### **What to expect from the CELTA training.**

This full-time (Monday to Friday, 8:00am – 16:00pm), 4-week course is very intensive and requires between 120 to 150 contact hours and a minimum of 50 self-study hours.

The class group sizes are limited to 12 teacher trainees, which helps to create a friendly atmosphere where every candidate is given personalised attention.

Each day consists of a balance of teaching practice, observations and teaching methodology. Evaluation is continuous and includes 6 hours of assessed teaching practice and 4 written assignments.

After your acceptance, a pre-course task will be given to you to complete before the start of the course. The pre-course task will get you thinking about different aspects of grammar and teaching using the communicative approach. For this, you will require a good grammar book. We can recommend 'Grammar for English Language Teachers' by M. Parrott (About R900) Available at the training centre.

After your acceptance to the CELTA course, a **deposit of 50%** is required to book and secure your place at the course. The outstanding balance is due 3 weeks before the start of the course. The CELTA trainee class intake is restricted as per Cambridge Assessment Rules.

**How to Apply**

STEP 1: Complete the attached application and email to us. Also downloadable from our website

STEP 2: After application assessment and, we will contact you to arrange a short personal interview. For applicants living outside Johannesburg or Cape Town area, the interview can be conducted on the telephone or Skype.

STEP 3: The interview involves a discussion of the pre-interview task, ideas about teaching and learning, details about the course structure and requirements, and an opportunity for candidates to ask further questions.

STEP 4: Enrolment is subject to the training centres acceptance of your application. On approval a 50% deposit is payable to the training centre to secure your place in the CELTA course.
