

What is a TEFL qualification and why is it important?



A TEFL (Teach English as a Foreign Language) certification is an internationally recognized qualification to teach English abroad or online and a critical component of your international teaching job application.



A TEFL certification (120-hours minimum) is commonly required qualification for new and experienced teachers who want to teach English either as a foreign or a second language to both adults and children abroad or online.
